Debbie, Dena, Tom and Jason Pugh love to cook and that is great news for the rest of us. They will be open Tuesday through Friday for lunch starting at 11 am, dinner available around 4 pm until closing at 8 pm. Saturday and Sunday they will offer breakfast also, opening at 8 am and closing at 8 pm on Saturday and Sunday at 1 PM. They are closed on Mondays.

If you have had the potato pancakes or have even seen a picture of them, wow, and everything is homemade. Maybe some cinnamon swirl french toast might be the ticket to get your day off and running.

If you measure out 2 feet and picture a hoagie, yes, that is available also. Boneless chicken wings with several sauces; hand cut from chicken breast with their own special breading; yes, we're getting hungry. Hand pressed hamburgers with fresh, not fro-

zen ground beef, homemade pierogis, homemade soups; it might be hard to choose.

For dinner, shrimp scampi or a flat iron steak; this is just a sampling of what is available. For folks familiar with the quality and friendly service they might have enjoyed previously at the Just Us Restaurant, at the same location, expect the best with Curtis Home Cooking. Classic Pot Roast

This is a nice easy to make meal. If you decide to cook your vegetables in with the roast it makes a nice one pot meal. You just have to make sure the pot you use is big enough to have room for the vegetables. Some ideas for vegetables are potatoes, onions, carrots, mushrooms, and green beans, added long enough before serving so they cook. They can be whole, quartered, or sliced. We are having this recipe tomorrow night for supper. It is one of our favorites.

- 4 Pound chuck, round, or rump of beef
- ¼ Cup of flour
- 3 Tablespoons of bacon grease, olive oil, or for low fat cooking use Pam
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 Cup water

Dredge the meat with flour and brown on all sides in bacon grease. Season with salt and pepper. Add water, cover, and cook slowly over low heat, 3 to 4 hours As liquid cooks away add more as needed. Serve with brown gravy and vegetables. If you feel adventurous, try these variations: Use tomatoes or tomato juice instead of water. Or how about after browning pour ¼ cup of horseradish over the meat. Or maybe before cooking cut slits in the meat and insert stuffed olives, pushing into the meat. I am getting hungry just from typing this!
